Note: Gematria in a very simple sense is the study of the various numerical values of the Hebrew letters and words. Since there is no separate numerical system in the Hebrew language, all Hebrew letters have a numerical value so it is a very legitimate and valuable form of study. There are many different forms of Gematria. The Gematria system used in this chart is "mispar hechrachi," also known as Normative value. The Ancient font used is an attempt to blend the ancient variants into a uniform and recognizable font set that accurately depicts the original meaning of each character.
